Outreach and Witness Ministry will continuously be in contact with our sick and shut-in members to make sure their needs are being met.

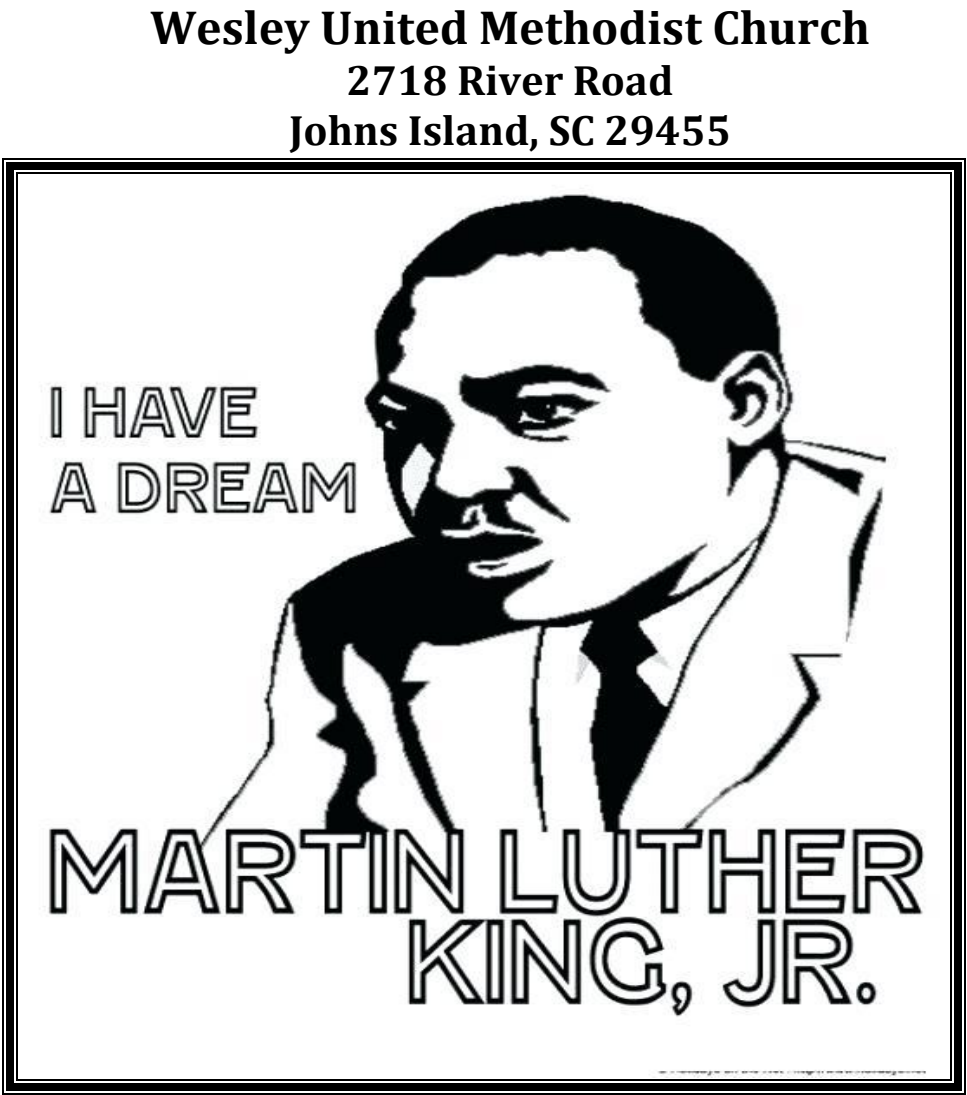
